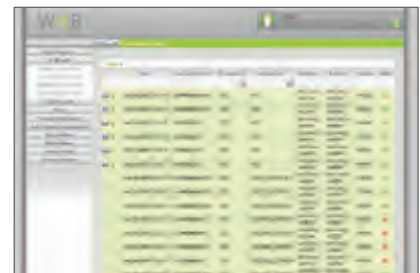


# Wallix AdminBastion - WAB5 & WAB15

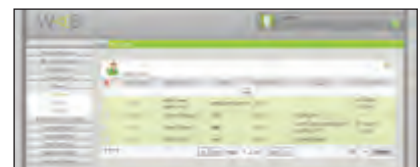
## Traceability and control over actions and connections

## Password management

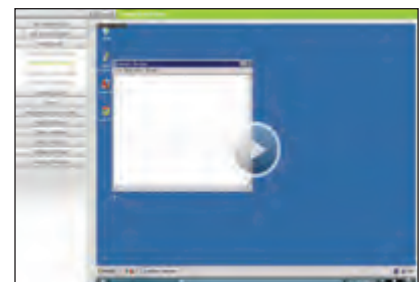

The WAB5 and WAB15 can manage all passwords and act as the central access point to network devices in your IT infrastructure. Each privileged user connects with a single login/password through the WAB. External providers do not have to remember these passwords. Hence, they are not communicated outside the company and not open to abuse. This feature guarantees that any external provider who no longer works for you will not have access to your IT infrastructure.

## React more quickly to security incidents

In case of an IT problem, the WAB5 and WAB15 allow you to replay system administrator sessions to find out precisely what happened, on which part of the infrastructure and on which device. Actions performed on target devices are continuously recorded for subsequent viewing. In Flash video format for graphical sessions under Windows Terminal Server (RDP) & VNC, and in text format for command-line sessions (SSH, Telnet).



## Agentless technology, simple and quick to deploy

The WAB5 and 15 integrate easily in your infrastructure, in a matter of hours. They do not bring any disturbances to implemented processes and allow IT administrators to continue use the tools they love. No software installed on the client or on the target devices.
